An honoree, having been graduated from Bowling Green High School at least 15 years, is one who has distinguished themselves in their personal relationships, civic endeavors, and professional careers by reflecting the highest values of BGHS- service, community, effort, and excellence- in everything they do.

Necessary Documentation Required:

For each candidate for the BGHS Hall of Honor, we are seeking detailed narrative descriptions for each of the areas listed below. A professionally prepared resume to support this nomination is helpful and may accompany this nomination form but is not required. One letter of recommendation **must** accompany this nomination in order for it to be considered. A maximum of three letters may be sent.

1. Present Employment Position with Job Description (*If Applicable*)
2. Professional and Career History, Professional Memberships, Leadership Positions, Professional Awards, Honors, Recognitions, and Accomplishments
3. Volunteer Service and/or Philanthropy to Their Community/State/Nation
4. Civic and/or Patriotic Service as a Public Servant or through Military Service in Civic or Fraternal Organizations, along with Leadership Positions, Accomplishments, Awards, and Recognitions
5. Personal and Family History including Educational Experiences, Degrees Attained, Educational Honors Awarded. Also Family Background for Immediate Family.
6. Any other additional information you believe is relevant to the above items to support this nomination.
